

Winter Family Retreat Master Schedule (Theme – Passover/Exodus)

Pool and Gym (Millbrook Main Office) is open every day 8 am to 9 pm. Shuttle runs between facilities every 20 min, from 8 am to 4pm.

Friday, March 13

6:00 pm – Arrival, placement (Volunteers and Jookender Crew comes at least an hour before)

6:30 pm – Ice breakers & candle holders decorations for kids (Tecumseh, Dining Room)

7:00 pm – Kabbalat Shabbat led by Teens, Including Passover Play – (Tecumseh, Dining Room)

7:30 pm – Shabbat Dinner

9:30 pm – Fireworks at the Mountain (dress for the outside, instructions TBD)

10:30 pm – Young Children go to sleep. Parents/Teens time:

- Jewish Cinematograph for Teens – Body and Soul (The State of the Jewish Nation) (Osceola Lodge, or at their rooms)

Saturday, March 14

8:00 am – Teen Vertical Challenge Registration by parents (at the Mountain)
