Toiletries

- Bath towels
- Soap in plastic container
- Antibacterial hand sanitizer
- Baby wipes
- Shampoo, toothbrushes, and toothpaste
- Deodorant
- Mosquito repellent for kids and adults
- Miniature sewing kit
- Any needed prescriptions

Clothing

- Shirts and t-shirts
- Warm sweaters or sweatshirts
- Shorts
- Long pants
- Pajamas or sweats for sleeping
- Underwear
- Socks
- Rain gear
- Comfortable shoes and sandals
- Hiking boots and/or sports sandals
- Rain Boots for Kids (or crocks)

Recreation

- Sunglasses
- Waterproof sunscreen
- Swimsuits and swim towels
- Water bottles
- Camera and memory card
- Outdoor toys such as kites, balls and frisbees
- Musical instruments and song books

Purchase a pre-assembled kit, or pack your own in a solid portable box:

- Sterile adhesive bandages in different sizes
- Gauze rolls and pads in different sizes
- Adhesive tape
- Scissors
- Tweezers (for splinters and ticks)
- Needle
- Latex gloves
- Cotton swabs
- Moistened towelettes
- Antiseptic wipes
- Hydrogen peroxide
- Antibiotic ointment
- Rubbing alcohol
- Lotion for insect bites and rashes
- Burn ointment
- Thermometer
